The Twenty-third Dasturji Dr Sohrabji H. Kutar Memorial Lecture, Thursday 4th June 2020, 6 pm

The Farrokh Vajifdar Memorial Lecture

Farrokh Jal Vajifdar passed away after a prolonged period of illness on Tuesday 21st November 2017. He was a Fellow (and former Vice-President and Fellow-in-Council) of the Royal Asiatic Society, and a review contributor to its Journal.

Farrokh belonged to a rapidly growing group of rational thinkers and educated scholars as he was fluent in the scriptures, written texts, ancient languages and their dialects. His presentations relied on hard evidences, references and quotes from ancient texts, the Gathas, Yasnas, Yashts, Niyaeshes, Rivayats; and various texts spanning a time frame of a 1000 years and also included references from later day research, as opposed to relying on rabid prejudices and misconceived notions based on hearsay which is often mistaken for "tradition". He was a wonderful speaker on religious matters and was a master in lifting the veil on the Gathas in simple language to the delight of the listener. Farrokh never failed to voice his feelings against uninformed priests.

The intent and purpose of Farrokh's lectures/ talks was to put forth information that was derived through long years of diligent and scholarly analyses and it was for the listener to absorb it, weigh it, and balance it against existing preconceived fallacies and finally arrive at their own conclusion. Farrokh was most certainly not a fanatical preacher raving from the pulpits! The lecture by Professor Antonio Panino at SOAS is dedicated to the memory of Farrokh Jal Vajifdar and to their lifelong friendship and collaboration.

Prof. Antonio C. D. Panaino is Full Professor of Iranian Studies at the "Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna"; until October 2008 he has been Dean of the "Faculty for the Preservation of the Cultural Heritage" in the Campus of Ravenna, where the "Ilya and Lisbeth Gershevitch Library" is located according to the generous wish of this scholar. The same Faculty has acquired the "J. P. Asmussen Library", which is presently at disposal of the consultants. Prof. Panaino has been Secretary and, then, President of the Societas Iranologica Europaea. Prof. Panaino was Director of

the Emilia-Romagna branch of the Italian Institute for Africa and the Orient. He founded with other scholars the International Association «MELAMMU» dedicated to the study of the intercultural phenomena in antiquity with special regard for the heritage of the Assyrian and Babylonian cultures. Prof. Panaino has been the Director of the Italian Scientific Mission in Tajikistan, where he dedicated a special investigation to the Yaghnob Valley and its people.
